Safer Internet Day

What is Safer Internet Day?

- A day to create awareness of a better internet for ALL users
- The theme for Safer Internet day is *"Together for a Better Internet"*
- Safer Internet Day is celebrated all across Europe on the second Tuesday, of the second month, every year.



Internet Safety & Online wellbeing

Cyberbullying - the act of bullying someone through electronic means.

If you do experience harassment or cyberbullying online:

1. **Don't reply to messages that harass or annoy you.**
2. **Keep the Message (take a screenshot)**
3. **Block the Sender.**
4. **Talk to someone you trust, & get support in school & at home.**

The Granny rule

Do not post anything you would not like your granny to see



Think Before you post

If you **post anonymously**.....ask yourself WHY??

Have you posted something unkind??

If you **like, share** or **comment** on these **negative posts** you are **supporting/encouraging** this behaviour.

What is my digital footprint?

Your digital footprint is a **record of your online activity**.

It shows where **you've been** on the internet and the **data you've left behind**.

Your footprint grows when you **deliberately share something online**, or when **sites and apps track** your activity.

Profile
Only use your first name. Do not give out any personal information.

Permission
Make sure you have permission to wear and share information online.

Privacy
Keep your passwords and personal details private.

Protect
Keep evidence and don't bully back, tell an adult.

Positive
Make sure the information you share is positive.

5 P's for a positive Digital Footprint

adapted from the Queensland Government

1. Sharing online

- The sharing of intimate content without consent is always **illegal**.
- When the participants are **under 18** it can even constitute a **breach** of the **criminal laws** which relate to **child pornography**.
