Further Education & Training Awards Council (QQI)

QQI awards guarantee learners more options, greater flexibility, high standards of quality, increased access and a ladder of progression into further Third Level Studies. Currently there are over 2,000 University & Institutes of Technology places reserved for holders of QQI Level 5 Awards.

Entry Requirements

- Leaving Certificate with passes in at least five subjects
- Leaving Certificate Applied with a minimum of 120 credits
- QQI Certification at Level 4
- Applicants over 21 years who may have not completed the Senior Cycle, but are deemed to have the necessary competence and capacity to undertake the programme may also apply.

General Information

There are no formal tuition fees for Irish and EU Nationals who are full time students on our courses. Courses are funded by the European Social Fund.

An administration fee is required to cover student services. Students are also required to pay examination fees.

Work Experience

Courses are designed to meet current employment market needs by providing job orientated training and education. Coláiste Mhuire Co-Ed has built extensive links with many businesses in the locality and further afield through their work experience programme.

Students complete a block release period of work experience during the year with many students finding employment locally as a result of their work experience.



Higher Education Link Scheme

Progression to Universities and other Colleges from QQI programmes delivered at Coláiste Mhuire Co-Ed is possible through the Higher Education Links Scheme (HELS).

This Scheme provides access from Level 5 and some Level 6 Advanced Certificates to a number of reserved places on higher education programmes through the CAO (Central Applications Office). Waterford Institute of Technology (WIT) and Technological University of the Shannon (TUS) provide a number of reserved places for all QQI Programmes in Coláiste Mhuire Co-Ed.

Students are responsible for checking entry routes to the individual Higher Education Institutes and the CAO websites to ensure they meet any special or essential requirements specified such as:

- A specific Major Award.
- A specific grade in specific components.
- Additional Award requirements such as mathematics.
- That all credits used for scoring purposes are achieved in one 'single sitting'

Learners who complete Advanced Certification Level 6 with CMCO may apply for advanced entry straight into the second year for some programmes. this is a Pilot scheme and will be reviewed annually. Be advised that course codes and titles may change and students are responsible for checking eligibility.

Support is available to further education students when they are registered with CMCO's further education college on all of this information.

Coláiste Mhuire Co Ed, partake in the higher education links scheme with both Technological University of the Shannon (TUS) and Waterford Institute of Technology (WIT), students are responsible for checking entry routes and progression pathways in this regard.

Application Forms are available to download from www.cmco.ie. Courses are offered subject to demand. Places on oversubscribed courses may be determined by interview. For students with additional learning needs, **see our website** for information regarding extra supports available.

Guidance Counselling
